

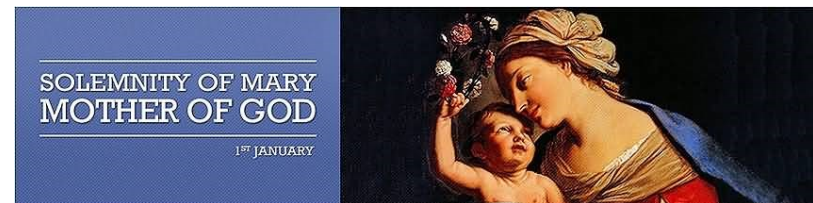



Luke 2:16-21

Profession of Faith - Nicene Creed

(*all bow*)




