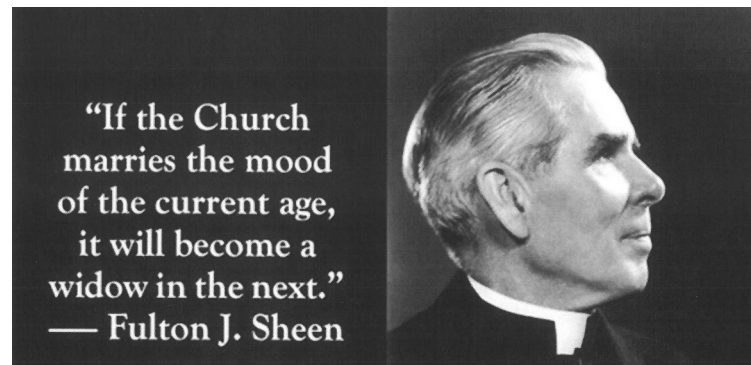



John 2:1-11

Profession of Faith - Nicene Creed


